







- 1. Registration: The applicant does not have to be the same as the person registered on the elane platform
- 2. Creating new application: After saving the project type and the title it is no longer possible to change the project type or to delete the application
- 3. Completing the forms and Attachments:

4. Finalise application: changes are no longer possible

5. Cover sheet to FWF: the processing will start, once the cover sheet has reached the FWF




### Reviewer profile in the peer review procedure

- Reviewers must be experts based outside of Austria who are still active in the field and have attained at least the same scholarly/scientific level as the applicant.
- Always selected specifically for each application, no fixed set of reviewers (never more than 2 reviews per year)
- Regional distribution according to share of scholarly/scientific output
- Increase in share of female reviewers aimed at
- In smaller disciplines, "generalists" may also be called upon.
- Negative list: exclusion of up to 3 reviewers
- Review of competence: abstract sent to reviewers
- Check on potential conflicts of interests/bias by FWF secretariat
- Declaration of interests: confirmation of declaration regarding bias

### **General information on reviews**

Quality standard: International scientific community

Peer review: Only reviewers based outside of Austria

FWF reporters: Subject-specific reviewer recommendations

FWF Executive Board: Responsible for nomination of reviewers

Number of reviews: At least 2 (additional reviews based on

funding requested)

Decision meetings: 5 per year

Decisions: Issued by FWF Board on basis of reviews

Multiple-party checks: Mutual review by 2 reporters, FWF office and

**Executive Board** 

Reasons:
Reviews (full content passed on to applicant)

Ex-post reviews: Peer review of final reports



### Summary: Key features of the FWF decision procedure

- Strictly bottom-up approach, no prescribed research topics, no preference for specific researchers
- Multiple-party checks in all steps of procedure and decisions
- Close interaction with applicant to maximise transparency
- Independent, international peer review as the basis for quality assurance
- Text of reviews as most important basis for decisions (ratings treated as mere indicators)
- Discussion of and decisions on all projects from all disciplines during an FWF Board meeting with representatives from all disciplines




### **Project Management**

- Start as early as possible and carry out the project quickly and efficiently.
- Take advantage of the flexibility allowed in carrying out the project:
  - Overall budget + 5% "General project costs"
  - Extension (without impact on costs) up to 24 months
- Remain within the limits of your budget. Additional funds are not provided.
- Use the funds within the planned time period (projects may be extended to 24 months without an impact on costs).



### **Quality assurance mechanisms**





### FWF quality assurance principles

- Stringent ex-ante evaluation
  international peer review procedure, maximum transparency and
  fairness: one decision-making body, strict multiple-party reviews for all
  decisions
- Maximum flexibility in project execution
   General budget, additional 5% for general project costs, no interim reports, etc.
- Result-oriented supervisory mechanisms
   Peer review of project report, capture of output data in FWF databases (publications, career progress, conference attendance, etc.)




### **Project documentation / final report**

- Annual statement of accounts and 1-page report
- Comprehensive final report consisting of 5 parts (total: approx. 2,400 words / 4 pages):
  - 1. Summary for PR-work (German and English)
  - 2. Brief project report
    - 2.1. Report on the scientific work
    - 2.2. Personnel development importance of the project for the scientific careers of those involved (including the project leader)
    - 2.3. effects of the project outside the scientific field
  - 3. Information on project participants
  - 4. Attachments: 6 lists (publications, conference participations, development of collaborations, habilitations/ PhD-/ diploma theses, effects of the project outside the scientific field, planned follow-up projects)
  - 5. Cooperation with the FWF

### **Summary**

- Do outstanding research work.
- Foster your employees' progress.
- Make international contacts.
- Publish your results as visibly as possible at the international level (leading journals, open access).
- Communicate your work and its results to a broader audience as well (project web site: use FWF templates).
- Pursue aspects which go beyond the field of science/research.
