

Tyrolean Science Fund - Call for Proposals 2022

The Tyrolean Provincial Government calls for proposals from:

- Scientists and young scientists of the Leopold-Franzens-University of Innsbruck, the Medical University of Innsbruck, the Private University of Health Sciences, Medical Informatics and Technology (UMIT), the University of Education Tyrol (PHT), the Kirchliche Pädagogische Hochschule Edith-Stein (KPH), the Management Center Innsbruck (MCI), the FH Kufstein and Center for Health Professions Tyrol (FHG), as well as any other Austrian or foreign scientists wishing to carry out a scientific project in one of the above mentioned universities and educational centers.

The objective of the Tyrolean Science Fund (TWF) is to promote scientific research and young scientists, as well as to secure the international scientific competitiveness, in Tyrol.

How to apply:

- Applications are to be submitted electronically via the homepage of the Tyrolean Science Fund (<https://www.tirol.gv.at/wirtschaft-wissenschaft>) at the Office of the Tyrolean Provincial Government, Heiligegeiststraße 7, 6020 Innsbruck.
- The application form as well as an information sheet will be available on the homepage of the Tyrolean Science Fund as of 01 February 2022.
- For the application please use exclusively the application form provided for the present call (01 February 2022 until 31 March 2022).
- The information in the application form must be written in German.
- The call 2022 starts 01 February 2022
- The call 2022 ends 31 March 2022
- The budget of the call 2022 is € 1.100.000

Funding volume:

The costs applied for from applicants of the Leopold-Franzens-University of Innsbruck must not exceed (total project costs) € 30.000,00 (excluding value added tax).

The costs applied for from applicants of the Medical University of Innsbruck must not exceed (total project costs) € 40.000,00 (excluding value added tax).

Selection procedure:

Applications received on time undergo a formal review by the Office of the Tyrolean Provincial Government.

After completion of the formal review step, the institutions named in § 3 of the guidelines are requested to organize the scientific review of the research proposals which fall within their sphere of responsibility. The institutions subsequently submit their funding recommendation to the Tyrolean Provincial Government (projects selected and extent of funding).

The Tyrolean Provincial Government then decides whether the selected research proposals will be funded or not. In this decision-making procedure, the Tyrolean Government may ask for the opinion of additional experts and may use existing expert opinions from other research funding institutions.
