

Ms Daniela Busti, a student in the first year of the Innsbruck PhD Programme in Neuroscience, has been awarded a stipend for a training stay by NENS (Network of European Neuroscience Schools). This award will allow Ms Busti to spend approximately two months at the MRC Anatomical Neuropharmacology Unit in Oxford in the laboratory of Dr. Capogna. Ms Busti is at the Dept. Pharmacology in the laboratory of Dr. Francesco Ferraguti, where she studies the cytoarchitectonic and neuropharmacology of the intercalated cell masses of the amygdala, a poorly understood area critically involved in fear learning.
