Since 2011: follow-up program to the MFI!

**Target group**: high qualified scientists (Post-docs) at the beginning of their scientific careers

#### **Objectives:**

- Enable young researchers to collect preliminary data that might serve as basis for a third-party funding application (e. g. FWF /ÖNB)
- Help young scientists to launch their scientific careers



#### **Basic information (I)**

#### Eligibility criteria

- Employment contract with the MUI
- Completed doctoral studies (applicants with a MD degree only if excellent track record/ no ongoing clinical PhD)
- ❖ Age limit (max. 35 yr)
- Experience in proposed research field (min. 2 publications as first author)
- Research proposal should be connected to the MUI research focuses:
- a) oncology, b) neurosciences, c) genetics, epigenetics & genomics, and d) Infectiology, immunology, & organ and tissue transplant

#### **Basic information (II)**



- Deadline: once a year (Spring)
- Submission of applications: online (http://fld.i-med.ac.at/public/garinfo.cgi)
- ❖ Application language: English
- ❖ Duration: max. 24 months
- ❖ Grant amount: € 30.000 per project Costs for personal only in exceptional cases and under strong argumentation (marginal employment contract)
- **❖ Approval rate:** 25-30%

#### Formal aspects – What do I need?



- Curriculum Vitae
- Publication list (indicating IF)
- ❖ Academic abstract (ca. 450 words)
- Proposal
- Itemization of the requested fund (<u>link</u>)
- ❖ Affirmation of the head of the department/division (link)
- ❖ Affirmation of the head of the MUI animal facilities (if needed) (link)

#### "The proposal"

- Cover sheet: Title, 5 Keywords, project duration
- 2. Background/state of the art
- 3. Objectives/Hypotheses
- 4. Working plan
- Methodology
- 6. Outlook/perspectives
- 7. Project schedule
- 8. Project costs
- 9. Cooperation partners inside and outside the MUI
- 10. References
- 11. Studies subjected to regulations
- 12. GSP
- 13. Double funding





#### **Evaluation procedure**

- First step: internal evaluation by members of the MUI-START Jury
- ❖ Second step: international peer-review (min. 2 reviews)
- Third step: personal interview with the MUI-START Jury (only for selected proposals/applicants)

# **Evaluation procedure – Questions for the jury members**



- Track record commensurate with applicant's academic age?
- Proposal is convincing/feasible?
- Proposal is connected to one of the MUI research focuses?
- Gender aspects are taken into account in the proposal?
- Proposal has potential to lead to an application for external funding?
- Do you recommend this proposal for external peer-review?

#### **Evaluation procedure – external reviewers**



- Applicant
- Professional qualities
- Potential to realize the project
- Project
- Originality
- Clarity of the concepts/methods
- Importance of the project
- Feasibility
- Adequacy of schedule
- Adequacy of the scientific environment/research institute

#### Take-home messages



- ❖ Stick to the guidelines if you do not fulfill the criteria don't apply
- Prepare your application with great care applications are reviewed by international experts – Compulsory!!! External funding application!!!
- ❖ If you are not sure Please call or write an e-mail: Better to ask in advance than to regret afterwards
