This month, Eurolife publishes it's first two calls for funding opportunities:

1.) Short-term Eurolife Research Exchanges. 1st round – 2016.

This funding scheme offers young researchers from the participating organisations the opportunity to apply for travel grants to another university in the network in order to initiate / intensify collaborations between them. 2.) Kick start grants to boost Eurolife member collaboration and participation in research projects within the Horizon 2020 framework programme
