### **Call for new SFB Draft Proposals**

Target group: all researchers Begin: 01.04.2016 / 00:01 CET End: 30.09.2016 / 23:59 CET Validity: Date of the postmark

Goal of the SFB is the establishment of research networks based on international standards through autonomous research concentration at a single university location. Researchers (a minimum of 5 and a maximum of 15 project part leaders including the speaker) should build up extremely productive, tightly interconnected research establishments for long-term and interdisciplinary work on complex research topics at one or under certain circumstances at more than one university locations. A target rate of 30 % female scientists / scholars is requested. At least 50% of the project part leaders have to be located at a single university location; commitment of all universities and research institutions participating.

#### The Lush Prize 2016- Animal Free Testing

The Lush Prize is a major initiative aiming to bring forward the day when safety testing takes place without the use of animals. It focuses pressure on toxicity testing for consumer products and

ingredients, in a way which complements the many projects already addressing the use of animals in medical testing.

The prize normally consists of a £250,000 annual fund – the biggest prize in the non-animal testing sector.

In most years, several prizes of £50,000 will reward the most effective projects and individuals who have been working towards the goal of replacing animals in product or ingredient safety testing across five strategic areas:

- Lobbying
- Public Awareness
- <u>Science</u>
- Training
- Young Researcher Awards
