



Requirement for Austrian Guest Professor and Austrian Academic or Researcher
visiting Thailand under the Exchange of Thai-Austrian Senior & Junior Scientist

Austrian Guest Professor visiting Thailand under the Thai-Austrian Cooperation on Science, Technology and Arts Project will receive a monthly honorarium of 50,000 baht (fifty thousand baht) from the Office of the Higher Education Commission. Before arriving Thailand, Austrian Guest Professor should inform the Thai host institution the exact date of his or her arrival and departure. The Thai host institution will inform the Office of the Higher Education Commission (OHEC), Ministry of Education, Thailand about the Guest Professor's visit and will make request to OHEC to prepare the honorarium for the visiting Austrian Guest Professor.

Austrian Academic or Researcher visiting Thailand under the Exchange of Thai-Austrian Senior Scientist Programme will receive a monthly honorarium of 30,000 baht (thirty thousand baht) and Junior Scientist Programme will receive a monthly honorarium of 20,000 baht (twenty thousand baht) for not more than three months from the Office of the Higher Education Commission . Before arriving Thailand, Austrian Academic or Researcher should inform the Thai host institution the exact date of his or her arrival and departure. The Thai host institution will inform the Office of the Higher Education Commission (OHEC), Ministry of Education, Thailand about the Austrian Academic or Researcher's visit and will make request to OHEC to prepare the honorarium for the visiting Austrian Academic and Researcher.

Austrian visitor coming to Thailand under the Thai-Austrian Cooperation on Science, Technology and Arts can come to the Office of the Higher Education Commission personally to receive the honorarium. If Thai host institution is in another city other than Bangkok, Austrian visitor can ask the Thai host institution to apply for the honorarium under his or her name and OHEC will send the honorarium to the Thai host institution to forward the honorarium to Austrian visitor afterward. Austrian visitor will be asked to sign in a receipt provided by OHEC.

When Austrian visitor has finished the visit to Thai host institution, OHEC requests Austrian visitor to write a summary of his or her activities and achievement when visiting Thai host institution. The summary will be sent to OHEC address below together with a signature of acknowledgement of a representative of Thai host institution one month after returning from Thailand.
