

- Since 2017 until 2019 President of the Italian Society of Organ Transplantation (SITO), Councillor since 2011 until 2014.
- Councillor in the Italian Association for the Study of the Liver (AISF) (2008-2011)
- Director of the Italian School of minimally invasive hepatobiliary Surgery (I GO MILS 2019-2022)
- Coordinator of the Italian College of Liver Transplant Centres since (2000-2017).
- **Italian co-representative at the European Board of Surgery**, section of Transplantation UEMS (European Union of Medical Specialists)(2010-present time).
- Member of ESOT Council (European Society for Organ Transplantation)(2017-2020). Co-chair the ESOT 2021 Congress.
- First author or co-author of 460 reviewed publications, 28 chapters and 5 monographs. H-INDEX 59 (Scopus) 70 (Google Scholar) (20423 Citations), mainly dedicated to transplant oncology, transplant allocation, immunosuppression, oncologic hepato-biliary surgery.
- Prof Cillo performed as first surgeon/tutor over 1000 liver transplants, more than 120 cases of pediatric liver transplantation including split child-adult and adult-adult, living donors, domino transplantation and over 4000 interventions of general and hepatobiliary surgery,
- He performed the first auxiliary liver transplantation (2007), the first liver auto-transplantation (2011), the first "RAPID" technique (2018) and the first "Dual Liver Transplantation" (2023) in Italy
